1. Study Design	Clear description of study design, including control groups.	
2. Sample Size	Explanation of sample size determination and number of animals used.	
3. Inclusion and Exclusion Criteria	Criteria for including or excluding animals/data.	
4. Randomisation	Methods used to allocate animals to experimental groups.	
5. Blinding	Whether investigators were blinded during allocation, conduct, and analysis.	
6. Outcome Measures	Clearly defined primary and secondary outcome measures.	
7. Statistical Methods	Detailed description of statistical methods used.	
8. Experimental Animals	Species, strain, sex, age, weight, and relevant characteristics.	
9. Experimental Procedures	Detailed description of procedures, interventions, and timing.	
10. Results	Summary of results, including effect sizes and measures of variability.	

Authors must ensure that all Essential 10 items are adequately reported in the manuscript. Non-compliance may result in the manuscript being returned for revision prior to peer review.
